ORDER

As per papers read (1), grace marks were granted to the students who excel in sports, games and NCC activities in their corresponding semesters in which the students secure their achievements. Further, a new proposal to allot grace marks to NCC cadets which was approved by the 64th Board of Studies (Faculty of Agriculture) was placed before the 138th meeting of Academic Council held on 22.07.2022. As per the decision of the 138th Council, a committee was constituted with the Dean of Faculty (Agriculture) as the Chairman, to study the proposal and to submit the report in the next Academic Council. The report of the Committee was approved by the Special meeting of the Academic Council, as per paper read (3).

In the circumstances sanction is hereby accorded for awarding of grace marks to the students who partake in NCC activities, with the following norms.

1	Attending Annual Training Camp of 10 days	1% (limited to one camp in an academic year)
2	Attending Inter Group Competition	i. Pre-RD 1-1% ii. Pre-RD 2-2%

		iii. Pre-RD 3-3% (the claim for grace mark shall be limited to any one camp whichever is higher)
3	Certificate	'B' Certificate- 2 %,
	Holders	'C' Certificate- 4%
4	Attending National Level camps	2% (limited to one camp in an academic year)
5	Participating in Independence Day Camp & Republic Day Camp	6%
6	Participating in Youth Exchange Programme	7%
7	NCC Cadets who wins National Awards	7%

As per Academic Handbook, Appendix XI, Clause 10, the grace marks will not be considered for the purpose of ranking.

Maximum grace marks granted to an NCC cadet will be restricted to 10% of the total maximum marks in a semester.
